4. To ensure the highest degree of integrity in the review process, please do not provide specific staff, school names or other Identifying characteristics in any of the following boxes. Example: “the students in my school will...” vs. “the students at Eastside Middle School will....,”
5. Teachers, administrators or academic support staff person (Entrant) in a public or charter school in the Greater Kansas City Metro counties may submit a grant application multiple times in a grant period provided each application is for a different activity.

What is the project timeline? Include any key events and tests dates throughout the year.

Who else from your school will be involved in the project i.e. peers, school staff, administrators, etc.? Give general titles only; no proper names.

How will you include the family/parents i.e. family homework assignment, family nights at school, PTA/PTO involvement, interviewing family members, home visits, etc.?

### **III. ASSESSMENT & MEASURABLE RESULTS (750 Word Maximum)**

Specify how you will measure your results i.e. surveys, test scores, homework assignments etc.?

How will you track your results to know if you've made progress since the beginning of the project?

Include how much change is needed for the project to be considered successful e.g. math test scores will increase by at least 10% after completion of the project when compared to math scores from the same group measured before implementing the project.
